

# WHO QUALIFIES?

## ELIGIBILITY FOR FAMILY MEDICAID

- Parents with dependent children, pregnant women, children age 18 and under
- Colorado residents
- US citizen, a legal permanent resident for at least 5 years, an asylee, a refugee or a noncitizen with a qualifying emergency
- Applicants within income guidelines

## ELIGIBILITY FOR CHP+

- Children age 18 and under and pregnant women
- Colorado residents
- US citizen, a legal permanent resident for at least 5 years, an asylee or a refugee
- Applicants not eligible for Medicaid
- Applicants within income guidelines
- Applicants who do not have other health insurance

# LOW OR NO-COST HEALTH INSURANCE OPTIONS

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Family Medicaid is no-cost public health insurance for low-income parents with dependent children, pregnant women, and children age 18 and under.

CHP+ is low-cost health insurance for children age 18 and under and pregnant women.

Medicaid and CHP+ are administered by the Colorado Department of Health Care Policy and Financing. Family Medicaid and CHP+ benefits include:

- Doctor's Visits
- Well Visits and Sports Physicals
- Shots (immunizations)
- Prescription Medications
- Hospital Visits
- Prenatal Care
- Developmental Screenings
- Oral Health Care

# PERSONAL STAFF ASSISTANCE

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Trained staff are available to provide you with one-on-one assistance through establishing eligibility and throughout the application process.

# WHO BENEFITS?

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If you know a family who fits one of these descriptions, they may be eligible if:

- A family member was recently laid-off from their job.
- Their employer cancelled or cut-back health insurance coverage.
- The family does not have health insurance.
- The family is paying 100% of their current health insurance premiums.
- Their child has become ineligible for Medicaid coverage based on their income.
